CAC and Public House have partnered to host an event that blends two unlikely subjects: art and beer! On August 8, guests will be able to view and taste their way through a combination of contemporary art inspired by local craft beers. Following a special commission opportunity organized by CAC earlier this spring, five local artists were selected to create an original artwork inspired by a local craft brew of their choice. The resulting works will be on display during the August 8 event and guests will be able to sample the chosen beers and talk to the artists about their muses, as they vote on their favorite pairing.

[Shawn Stucky](#) screenprint installation inspired by the ritualistic and celebratory gesture of sharing Finch's Golden Wing beer.
